For this project, each of you will create your own TrackStar track. You will be responsible for supplying 5 sites.

Annotations demonstrate competence in writing skills (spelling, grammar, mechanics of writing). Annotation should include your initials. Initials not included indicating ownership. 0 points	There are one or two errors in spelling, grammar, and/or mechanics. 5 points	There are no noticeable errors in spelling, grammar, or mechanics. Each annotation include initials indicating ownership. 10 points	
Descriptive words are used to create left-side navigation links.	No attempt has been made to use descriptive or appropriate words. 0 points	Words chosen are inappropriate for grade level or appear too lengthy. 2 points	Words are appropriate and descriptive without being overly long. 5 points

****FAQ: What is an "adequate annotation"?** An adequate annotation includes the following: a description of the site the student is viewing, what specifically the student is to read, do, or see; and a specific task or question with a recordable response.
